Shortly after April 1, 2030, you will receive an email from the Census Bureau inviting you to respond online to the 2030 Census, the 25th Decennial Census of the U.S. population.

The questionnaire you will complete is used to count people who are living, staying, or receiving services in group quarters on April 1, 2030. Some examples of group quarters include college or university residence halls, group homes, residential treatment centers, and workers' group living quarters.

The questionnaire has been developed specifically to make sure we count you at the right location. You will be asked some questions to confirm where you are living or staying on April 1, 2030.

When you receive the Census Day email, please click the link and log into the system with your unique Census ID to start the interview. This is your personal ID and must not be shared with anyone. The questionnaire should take only 10 minutes to complete.
