In 2019, CDC awarded funding to 59 state, local, and territorial health departments via the PS19-1901 cooperative agreement Strengthening Sexually Transmitted Disease (STD) Prevention and Control for Health Departments (STD PCHD). Through this cooperative agreement, recipients are expected to carry out a focused scope of work that reflects the core public health functions of assessment, assurance, and policy and aligns with STD epidemiology and best practices. CDC supports these health department recipients to: # Conduct STD surveillance # Respond to STD-related outbreaks # Identify persons with STDs and link them and their partners to care and to treatment through targeted disease investigation and intervention # Promote CDC-recommended screening, diagnosis, and treatment practices among relevant providers # Disseminate local data and information to the health care community and public; monitor and develop STD-related policy # Develop and strengthen multi-sector partnerships to support STD prevention and control # Support HIV prevention goals and collaborate with health department HIV programs; and # Analyze and use data for increased program insights and program improvement. CDC has developed a data collection tool to collect and evaluate

performance measures from the recipients, assess recipients# individual and collective progress towards the larger aims of the cooperative agreement, direct technical assistance to recipients, and obtain information needed to help assess the cooperative agreement#s public health impact. The data collection tool will be administered via e-mail annually around the mid-year mark, and recipients will submit their data via GrantSolutions by November of each year until data collection ends in 2027. Performance measures include data collection on pregnancy ascertainment, congenital syphilis, outbreak response, syphilis disease investigation and intervention, HIV prevention in disease investigation, and syphilis treatment.
