| 1           | <p><b>How's It Going?</b></p> <p><b>Everyone deserves to have partners who listen to what they want and need.</b></p> <p>Caring relationships involve:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Love and respect</li> <li>• Communication that doesn't blame the other person when there are problems</li> <li>• Space to spend time with other people</li> <li>• Supporting the other person's hopes and dreams</li> <li>• Both partners consenting to intimacy and sexual activity</li> <li>• Working together as parents, if you have children</li> </ul> <p>These qualities can lead to better health and a longer, happier life.</p>                                                                                                                                          |
| 2           | <p><b>Conflict Happens</b></p> <p><b>All relationships have conflict, but sometimes they become abusive, such as when a person:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Shames or humiliates the other</li> <li>• Controls where the other person goes and how they spend their money</li> <li>• Spies on the other person</li> <li>• Hurts or scares the other with their words or actions</li> <li>• Makes the other engage in sexual behaviors when they don't want to</li> <li>• Keeps the other from their job or school</li> </ul> <p><b>These experiences are common. Most people know someone who has been hurt by a partner or caregiver in their lifetimes.</b> If something like this is happening to you or a friend, call or text the hotlines on this card.</p> |
| 3           | <b>Helping a Friend or Family Member</b>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                               |

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|   | <p>Even if you haven't experienced abuse in your relationship, chances are you know someone who has been abusive or has been abused. You can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tell them they are not alone</li> <li>• Offer encouragement and support</li> <li>• Give them this card and say: "Hey, someone gave this to me. It has ideas on places you can go for support and things you can do to have a stronger and safer relationship."</li> </ul> <p><b>When you help others, it helps you too!</b></p>                           |
| 4 | <p><b>Abuse Can Affect Your Health</b></p> <p><b>Whether you have experienced abuse or have been abusive, your health can be negatively impacted.</b></p> <p>Abuse is connected to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Stress and anxiety</li> <li>• High blood pressure</li> <li>• Drug and alcohol misuse</li> <li>• Unplanned pregnancies and sexually transmitted diseases</li> <li>• Trouble sleeping and depression</li> </ul> <p>Talking to your health provider about these connections can help them take better care of you.</p> |
| 5 | <p><b>Difficult Childhoods</b></p> <p>Many people (1 in 4) grew up in homes where there was abuse or other difficult situations.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Maybe someone was hurting you or someone you love.</li> <li>• Maybe you were worried about where you would live or having enough food to eat.</li> <li>• Maybe your family couldn't care for you how they wanted to, or they weren't around.</li> </ul> <p>Childhood can be painful, but healing is possible.</p>                                                      |
| 6 | <p><b>Stronger You</b></p> <p><b>There are things you can do to feel stronger and to help you heal from past harm.</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Focus on empathy and not self-blame for our childhood experiences.</li> <li>• Talk it out with someone you trust.</li> <li>• Embrace your individual, community, and cultural strengths and values to help you heal.</li> <li>• Move your body - it calms the brain and body and helps you feel better.</li> </ul>                                                               |

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|            | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Breathe deeply and slowly.</li> <li>• Go for a walk, splash cold water on your face, be aware of negative thoughts, and change what you say to yourself.</li> </ul> <p><b>Seek support within your community, friends, and family, or talk to a professional for counseling, therapy, or life coaching.</b></p>                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                                             |
| 7          | <p><b>Safety Planning</b></p> <p>If your partner is hurting you, it is not your fault. You deserve to be safe and treated with respect.</p> <p><b>“Safe” looks different for everyone. Here are some things that can help:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Remember what you have done in the past that has worked to keep you safe.</li> <li>• Prepare an emergency kit with money, a phone charger, keys, medicines, birth certificates, and shot records in case you have to leave quickly.</li> <li>• Talk to people in your life who can help you get safer.</li> <li>• Call the hotline numbers included in this card.</li> </ul>             |
| 8          | <p><b>You Can Change</b></p> <p>If you have been abusive in your relationship, you can choose to change your behavior and heal from past harm.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Learn more about abusive behaviors, including emotional, financial, and sexual abuse.</li> <li>• Look at yourself honestly and take responsibility for your behavior.</li> <li>• Seek support - there are programs that can support you in changing your behavior.</li> </ul> <p><b>Change can be hard; it requires seeking new pathways, thinking, responses, and directions. But all your relationships will benefit, and you will feel better about yourself.</b></p> |
