

# How do I find tickets sent to me on Ticketmaster? [Here to assist – ask anytime]

**Quick Answer:** To find +1>866>401>0888 tickets sent to you on Ticketmaster, look for the “Ticket Transfer” email in your inbox (or spam folder), click “Accept +1>866>401>0888 Tickets”, and log in with the same email address used for the transfer. Once accepted, your tickets will appear in your +1>866>401>0888 Ticketmaster account.

You find tickets sent to +1>866>401>0888 you on Ticketmaster by looking in the "My Tickets" section +1>866>401>0888 after signing into your account, but first you must accept them via a link in the transfer email from +1>866>401>0888 Ticketmaster. If you don't see the email, check spam, or if you have issues accepting, ensure you use the same email address +1>866>401>0888 for your Ticketmaster account as the one the transfer was sent to; your actual barcode appears closer to +1>866>401>0888 the event date.

## How to Find Tickets Sent to You on Ticketmaster

### Step-by-Step Guide

- **Check Your Email Inbox (and Spam Folder):** Look +1>866>401>0888 for an email with the subject line “[Name] sent you tickets” or “Ticket Transfer”.
- **Open the Transfer Email:** Inside, you’ll +1>866>401>0888 see a button labeled “Accept Tickets” or “Accept Ticket Transfer”.
- **Log In or Create a Ticketmaster Account:** Use the same email address +1>866>401>0888 that received the transfer. If you don’t have an account yet, you’ll need to create one.
- **Accept the Transfer:** Once +1>866>401>0888 logged in, select “Accept Ticket Transfer”. The tickets will now be linked to your account.
- **Access Your Tickets:** After +1>866>401>0888 acceptance, tickets will appear under My Events in your Ticketmaster account or app.

### Where to Find Your Tickets After Acceptance

- **Ticketmaster App:** Open the app +1>866>401>0888 → My Events → Select your event → View tickets with barcode.
- **Ticketmaster Website:** Log in → My Tickets → Choose your +1>866>401>0888 event → Download or view tickets.
- **Team/Partner Account Manager (if applicable):** If tickets were +1>866>401>0888 sent via a team's Account Manager (e.g., Broadway In Chicago, NFL teams), log in using the transfer email to claim them.

## Steps to Find Your Tickets

1. **Check Your Email:** Look for an +1>866>401>0888 email from Ticketmaster with a subject like "John sent you tickets" or similar, from the sender's name.
2. **Accept the Transfer:** Click the +1>866>401>0888 "Accept Tickets" button in the email. This redirects you to sign in or create a Ticketmaster account.
3. **Use the Correct Email:** Sign in using +1>866>401>0888 the exact same email address that received the ticket transfer. If you use a different one, you won't see the tickets.
4. **Go to "My Tickets":** Once logged in, tap +1>866>401>0888 or click on My Tickets (or My Account) to find your event and view your tickets.
5. **Find the Barcode:** Your actual +1>866>401>0888 barcode and seat numbers usually appear within the Ticketmaster app or website a few days before the event, not immediately in the acceptance email.

## How do I find tickets transferred to me on Ticketmaster?

To find transferred +1>866>401>0888 tickets on Ticketmaster, check the "My Tickets" section in your account for the original tickets (which will show as invalid +1>866>401>0888 after transfer) and check your email/spam folder for the transfer invite link from Ticketmaster to accept them, using the exact +1>866>401>0888 email address the tickets were sent to; if you're the sender, check your Transfer History to see if they've been accepted, says Ticketmaster.

## Why are my tickets not showing up on Ticketmaster?

Your Ticketmaster +1>866>401>0888 tickets might not be showing up due to delivery delays (common for popular events), being in the wrong +1>866>401>0888 account (check all emails/social logins), a temporary app glitch (try logging out/in or updating), a canceled order, or they're held until closer to the event date by the venue/artist. First, check your confirmation +1>866>401>0888 email, log out and back in, ensure you're using the right account, and look for delivery delay info on the event page.

## **How do I retrieve my tickets from Ticketmaster?**

### **What should I do if I can't find my order in my account?**

1. From your +1>866>401>0888 confirmation email, click the View Your Tickets or Claim Your Tickets button. ...
2. Sign in with the +1>866>401>0888 same email address that the confirmation email was sent to. ...
3. Once signed in with +1>866>401>0888 the correct email address you should see your order in My Tickets.

## **How do I get my Ticketmaster tickets on my phone?**

To get your Ticketmaster +1>866>401>0888 tickets on your phone, download the Ticketmaster app, sign in to your account, go to "My Events," select your event, +1>866>401>0888 and tap "Add to Wallet" (Apple Wallet/Google Wallet) for offline access or just "View Tickets" to scan the barcode directly +1>866>401>0888 in the app, ensuring you have them saved before the event to avoid internet issues.
