To make and complete a nomination for an NEA Jazz Masters Fellowship, you must:

- 1) Enter the first and last name of the individual you wish to nominate;
- 2) Indicate if the nomination is for the performer or advocate category;
- 3) Attach the two (2) required PDF supporting documents as described in the [guidelines](#);
- 4) Provide the required nominator information; and
- 5) Click submit.

A nominee must be a living U.S. Citizen or permanent resident of the United States.

Nominations must be submitted in English.

Incomplete nominations will not be accepted.
