SAMHSA is requesting the following changes from the CSAT's GPRA Client/Participant Outcome Measurement Tool. These changes will not impact the current burden hours:

- Replaced the question "what do you consider yourself to be" with "what is your sex" and maintained only the "female" and "male" response options.
- Removed follow-up question on "Do you think of yourself as..." and its response options related to "gender identity".
- Removed one of the sub-categories "cultural interventions/activities' under treatment services for the question on planned services provided under grant funding.
