Re: Comments on Proposed Information Collection Activity; National Medical Support Notice Part A (Office of Management and Budget No. 0970-0222); 90 F.R. 26818 (June 24, 2025)

PayrollOrg supports OCSS's proposed information collection with changes to the National Medical Support Notice (NMSN) Part A. Payroll professionals greatly appreciate agency efforts to standardize and simplify employer processes for the reporting of child support, especially for more complicated procedures like the NMSN.

Recommendation

An important function of OCSS is to assist state child support agencies and employers to better manage child support reporting and withholding. The NMSN is an important part of that support.

While outside the scope of this information collection proposal, PayrollOrg asks OCSS to address states and localities with their own medical support notices in addition to the

NMSN. These separate state notices create an administrative burden on employers because they are duplicative and unnecessary. States and localities with separate notices include California, District of Columbia, New York, and South Dakota. If states and localities require additional information, they should recommend changes to the NMSN. The additional notices defeat the purpose of standardization.
