Abstract: VA Form 26–4555 is used to gather the necessary information to determine the eligibility for the Veteran or service member for specially adapted housing or for a special home adaptation grant. The estimated respondent burden has increased to account for documentation requirements associated with construction and adaptation activities, which increased the number of participating respondents from 7,000 to 11,200 and, in turn, increased the total annual burden hours.

An agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to a collection of information unless it displays a currently valid OMB control number. The **Federal Register** Notice with a 60-day comment period soliciting comments on this collection of information was published at 91 FR 24034 on May, 4, 2026.

Abstract: VA requires applicants for national cemetery burial to provide information to verify eligibility for burial in a national cemetery, to schedule interment and to provide services requested by the decedent's family or personal representative. This information (via the VA Form 40–4962) is also used for planning and scheduling cemetery services and to provide for specific requests from family members or the personal representative.

An agency may not conduct or sponsor, and a person is not required to respond to a collection of information unless it displays a currently valid OMB control number. The **Federal Register** Notice with a 60-day comment period soliciting comments on this collection of information was published at 91 FR 16811, April 02, 2026. This is a revision due to VA Form 40–4962 changing to remove ‘WWI’ as an option under Period of Service and changing ‘Korean’ to ‘Korea’ under Period of Service.
