



The Center for Tobacco Products (CTP) Research Involving Human Subjects Committee's (RIHSC) final determination is that the National Youth Tobacco Survey (NYTS) meets the definition of "public health surveillance activities," and therefore it does not constitute research as defined by the 2018 Common Rule. As such, the NYTS is not required to be subject to FDA IRB's review.

Public reporting burden for this collection of information is estimated to average 30 minutes per survey, including time for reviewing instructions, searching existing data sources, gathering and maintaining the data needed, and completing and reviewing the collection of information.
