Abstract The Brady Handgun Violence Prevention Act of 1993 required the United States Attorney General to establish a NICS that any FFL may contact by telephone or other electronic means, for the information to be supplied immediately, or whether the receipt of a firearm to a prospective purchaser would violate state or federal law. FFLs must enroll in the NICS in order to legally conduct checks on the NICS.
