New Information To Be Collected

U.S. Government departments and agencies involved in screening and vetting, to include USCIS, identified 24 data elements that would constitute a new baseline threshold of data to be collected for identity verification and national security vetting. For USCIS, these data elements will be added to certain immigration benefit request forms where the information is not already collected.

The 24 core data elements are as follows:

1. Name (Last Name, First Name, Middle (if applicable))
2. Alias(es)
3. Sex (Male or Female)
4. Date of Birth
5. Place of Birth (City, State/Province, and Country of Birth)
6. Country/Countries of Citizenship
7. Country of Residence
8. Passport/Travel Document or National ID
 - a. Country of issuance
 - b. Issue date
 - c. Expiration date
9. Telephone Number(s) used in the last five (5) years, including dates used
10. Email address(es) used in the last ten (10) years
11. U.S. Address: Residence or Destination, city, street
12. U.S. Address: Residence or Destination, state/province
13. Foreign Address city, street
14. Foreign Address state/province
15. Point of Contact Name (U.S. or other)
16. Point of Contact Telephone Number
17. Point of Contact Email Address
18. Family Member Names (parent, spouse, siblings, and children): (Last Name, First Name, Middle (if applicable))
19. Family Member Telephone Numbers (parent, spouse, siblings, and children) used in the last five (5) years
20. Family Member Date(s) of Birth (parent, spouse, siblings, and children)
21. Family Member Place(s) of Birth (parent, spouse, siblings, and children)
22. Family Member Residence(s) (parent, spouse, siblings, and children)
23. Business Telephone Number(s) used in the last five (5) years
24. Business Email Address(es) used in the last ten (10) years
