The U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) is now collecting data on Form EIA-64A, **Annual Report of the Origin of Natural Gas Liquids Production** for calendar year <REPORT YEAR>. Form EIA-64A is due to EIA no later than <DUE DATE>.

Submission details can be found in the instructions or on the EIA-64A form. The EIA-64A Form and Instructions can be downloaded at <a href="https://www.eia.gov/survey/#eia-64a">https://www.eia.gov/survey/#eia-64a</a>. It is recommended that you send your form electronically using <a href="Secure File Transfer">Secure File Transfer</a> to EIA. Instructions to file your form using this method can be found in the form's instructions.

The timely submission of Form EIA-64A by those required to report is mandatory under Title 15 U.S.C. §772(b), as amended. Failure to respond may result in a civil penalty of not more than \$13,273 each day for each violation. The government may bring a civil action to prohibit reporting violations that may result in a temporary restraining order or a preliminary or permanent injunction without bond. In such civil action, the court may also issue mandatory injunctions commanding any person to comply with these reporting requirements.
