The Section 8(a) Asbestos application or component that will support the new rule following EPA's June 2016 designation of Asbestos as one the first ten chemicals to undergo risk evaluation under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA). The Asbestos application/component will collect data related to the use of asbestos (including other types of asbestos fibers in addition to chrysotile), legacy uses and associated disposals, as well as any conditions of use of asbestos in talc and talc-containing products.

Paperwork Reduction Act Notice
