

Process for Removing Unreasonable Locations for Carriers with More RDOF Locations
Information to be Submitted to Online Portal

(Note: This is a representative description of the information to be collected via the online portal and is not intended to be a visual representation of what each applicant will see).

Item Number	Field Description	Purpose/Instructions
1	Carrier Name	This is the name of the carrier submitting this form
2	Service Provider Identification Number (SPIN/498 ID)	This is the unique 9-digit number assigned to service providers by USAC when a FCC Form 498 is filed
3	Study Area Code	Study area code applicable to the relevant RDOF service area
4	State	The state for which the carrier is making the filing
5	Fabric Location ID(s)	A number that uniquely identifies the location(s) from the Broadband Serviceable Location Fabric—a dataset of all locations in the United States and its Territories where fixed broadband internet access service is or could be installed
6	Reason why location(s) is unreasonable to serve	Predefined list of reasons for why the carrier is requesting removal of the location from its require list; will also include an "Other" field for carrier to manually input a reason not included in

		the preselected list
7	Evidence to demonstrate location(s) is unreasonable to serve	Upload field for carrier to submit evidence demonstrating that the location(s) is unreasonable to serve
8	Comments	Field for carrier to input any comments related to its submission
9	Whether the carrier is requesting confidential treatment of the submitted evidence	Checkbox for carrier to select if it is seeking confidential treatment of its submission
10	Filer Contact Name	Name of the carrier contact person
11	Filer Contact Phone Number	Phone number of the carrier contact person
12	Filer Contact Email address	Email address of the carrier contact person
13	Officer certification regarding served locations	Certification that the carrier has or will have served the minimum number of locations estimated by the Connect America Cost Model
