Welcome to the US Navy JAG Corps Online Application

Use this online application for the following programs:

Full-Time, Active Duty (Student Program (SP) and Direct Appointment (DA))

- **Student Program (SP)** – The Navy JAG Corps SP permits law students to receive a professional recommendation while attending law school, and become an officer candidate following medical screening and background checks. Upon graduation and successful completion of a bar examination, the officer candidate will earn their commission at the Navy officer training course, and commission as lieutenants (junior grade). This is our largest source of new attorneys for the Navy JAG Corps.
- **Direct Appointment (DA)** – The Navy JAG Corps DA permits licensed attorneys to be professionally recommended and become officer candidates. Upon successful completion of officer candidate training, DA applicants will earn their commission as lieutenant (junior grade) in the Navy JAG Corps.

Internship/Externship

- **Internship** – The Navy JAG Corps internship program is offered in the summer each year, for either 8 or 10 weeks. This unpaid internship is available to any law student who has completed at least one full year of academic study at an ABA Accredited law school.
- **Externship** – The Navy JAG Corps externship program is offered during the academic year, in a part-time status.

NOTE: This application is **NOT** for applying to the Navy JAG Reserves, the Law Education Program (LEP), nor the In-Service Procurement Program (IPP).

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Application Instructions



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Apply Online Instructions

Applicants are directed to thoroughly read through the instructions below. Non-compliance with submission requirements may be noted and briefed to the Accession Selection Board.

This web site enables you to submit a preliminary application for the U.S. Navy Judge Advocate General's Corps (JAG Corps) Direct Appointment or Student Program. The application process consists of several steps:

- Create an online account.
- Passwords must be at least 14 characters. Passwords must contain characters from at least three of the following four classes: uppercase, lowercase, number, and non-alphanumeric (special).
- Log in and Select Manage My Applications then Start New Application in the top Navigation bar
- Begin entering data into the various application sections. If needed, you may log out and return at a later time to enter or update any section.
- When done entering all required sections, preview your application to verify it for accuracy.
- Submit your online application.
- Upload all required documents.

By submitting an online application along with all requested documents, you may receive a professional recommendation for a commission from the Navy's JAG Corps Accessions Selection Board. If this application results in a favorable recommendation, it does not guarantee you a commission nor does it require the Navy to offer you a commission into the Navy JAG Corps. You must submit an official application for a commission via your Navy Recruiting District (NRD) to be considered for a commission. That application is an entirely different form and must be obtained and submitted through the NRD. The Navy may or may not offer you a commission based on the results of your complete and official application package, including but not limited to, the medical examination and security screening

Only complete applications submitted by the application deadline will be considered.

Required Documents (to be sent online)

- Résumé.
- Law school and undergraduate transcripts. Transcripts should show your class standing and school grading system.
- A full length professional photo (4x6 or 5x7) in business attire.
- If an applicant completed the GRE as part of the Law School or Program admission, proof of the GRE score is required along with the school's program authorization.
- LSAT Score. A copy of the Official Candidate LSAT Score Report, LSAC online services score report, or the official law school LSAT score report is acceptable.
- Letters of recommendation (minimum of three and maximum of five). Letters should be addressed to the "President of the JAGC Accessions Board". The Board reserves the right to contact the individuals who provide letters of recommendation.
- Applicants who are former members of the U.S. Armed forces (active or reserve) must provide a copy of DD Form 214, Certificate of Release or Discharge from active-duty.
- An applicant who submits more than the authorized 5 Letters of Recommendation will be deemed non-compliant, and only the first five Letters will be reviewed by the Accession Selection Board.
- Applicants who are current or former members of the U.S. Armed forces (active or reserve) must submit their last five fitness or evaluation reports.
- Direct Appointment Applicants Only: Proof of bar license to practice law

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a United States citizen of good moral character.
- Must be younger than 42 years of age at the time of commissioning.
- Must be a second- or third-year law school student attending an American Bar Association (ABA)-accredited law school (Student Program); or must have earned a JD from an ABA-accredited law school and be a member of a state or Federal Bar (Direct Appointment Program). *These requirements are to receive a professional recommendation only.

Applicant Action Requirements. Applicants are directed to ensure the following action items are completed before the deadline for this cycle. Failure to meet deadlines and requirements is reflective of applicant's fitness for military service:

- Schedule and complete a structured interview. These interviews are scheduled through your regional recruiting officer team with two judge advocates. Requests for interviews should be submitted **at least** 15 days before the cycle deadline. Late interview request submissions may not be facilitated where interview slots are not available. Requests submitted within the last 2–3 days before the end of the cycle may be summarily denied.
 - Submit the completed application no later than 2359 on the deadline date.
