General Comment

One of the fellows in this program should conduct a full-scale investigation into how the CDC has enabled measles to re-enter the United States through the open southern border. Measles, a highly contagious respiratory virus, was declared eliminated from the United States in 2000; however, with ongoing global transmission, infections in the United States still occur, largely due to illegals. Fifty-seven measles cases were associated with residence in or contact with persons in a migrant shelter in Chicago, Illinois before 2024. Most cases occurred in unvaccinated persons. A prompt and coordinated response with a high-coverage mass vaccination campaign reduced the size and duration of the outbreak, at the taxpayer's expense. Why are American cities allowed to declare themselves sanctuaries to contagious diseases? When will you be placing illegals in vaccination camps for the safety of American children?
