I hereby acknowledge that:

No attorney representing a **non-9/11-related victim** of state sponsored terrorism shall charge, receive, or collect, and the Special Master shall not approve, any payment of fees and costs that in the aggregate exceeds **25 percent** of any payment made under the Justice for United States Victims of State Sponsored Terrorism Act, as amended (the Act). No attorney representing a **9/11-related victim** of state sponsored terrorism shall charge, receive, or collect, and the Special Master shall not approve, any payment of fees and costs that in the aggregate exceeds **15 percent** of any payment made under the Act. The attorney shall certify compliance with this statutory limitation and shall provide such information as the Special Master requires ensuring such compliance. An attorney who violates this limitation on fees shall be fined under title 18, United States Code, imprisoned for not more than one (1) year, or both. See 34 U.S.C. § 20144(f).
