Re: Public Comment on Circular 230 Paperwork Burden (OMB 1545-1726)

Dear Mr. Garcia,

I am submitting this comment in response to Notice 2025-20271 concerning the paperwork burden associated with Circular 230.

As a certified public accountant in public practice, I believe the cumulative compliance burden related to enrollment, renewal, continuing education tracking, and provider reporting is understated in current estimates. A significant portion of practitioner time is spent navigating disconnected systems, duplicative data entry, and manual processes rather than complying with substantive professional requirements.

Meaningful burden reduction could be achieved through improved use of technology. A centralized practitioner portal that consolidates enrollment status, renewals, continuing education reporting, and IRS correspondence would be particularly helpful. In addition, automated continuing education reporting from approved providers and pre-populated renewal forms using prior-year data would reduce compliance time while improving accuracy and consistency.

I appreciate the opportunity to provide comments and encourage the IRS to continue modernizing Circular 230 administration in a manner that supports compliance without unnecessary administrative burden.
