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G-28, Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Accredited Representative

Form G-28, Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Accredited Representative is for attorneys and accredited representatives to provide information to establish their eligibility to appear for and act on behalf of an applicant, petitioner, requester, beneficiary or derivative, or respondent in immigration matters.

An attorney or accredited representative must complete and submit a new Form G-28 for each benefit request. Form G-28 can be started along with a client's new case or it can be added to a client's already-submitted case. USCIS will only recognize a completed Form G-28 once the client has reviewed and signed the form.

Each attorney or accredited representative appearing in a case must submit their own Form G-28 and USCIS only recognizes one Form G-28 at a time.

Note: For matters before the Department of Justice, Executive Office for Immigration Review (EOIR), representatives must file a **Form EOIR 27, Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Representative Before the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA)** for representation before the BIA, or **Form EOIR-26, Notice of Entry of Appearance as Attorney or Representative Before the Immigration Court** for representation before the Immigration Courts.

After You Complete The Form

Your client adds you as their representative

Withdrawing Form G-28

An attorney or accredited representative or the applicant, petitioner, requester, beneficiary or derivative, or respondent may withdraw Form G-28 at any time through their USCIS online account by navigating to the associated case and selecting "Withdraw G-28" from the "Case Actions" dropdown. Form G-28 may also be withdrawn by submitting written notice of withdrawal to DHS, or by submitting a **valid new Form G-28, to replace the previous one**. The applicant, petitioner, requester, beneficiary or derivative, or respondent will be treated as unrepresented unless a new Form G-28 is submitted.

USCIS will not accept a request for withdrawal from a law student, law graduate, or paralegal.
