Comment

(1) The FAA must prohibit the use of UAS for unauthorized surveillance, directed energy emissions, and acoustic harassment in residential and public spaces.

I have experienced harmful electromagnetic exposure, directed energy harassment and signal interference originating from aerial devices operating in residential areas. I have collected evidence with measurement devices and shared the bearings of these drones with FAA Inspector Gerald A Dotson.

I am particularly concerned that this targeting may be linked to my prior online speech and commentary, raising serious questions about the potential misuse of advanced surveillance and electromagnetic technologies to chill or penalize lawful expression.

Based on publicly available information, I suspect the following defense subcontractors—MAG Aerospace and RPS Defense—may be involved in these activities. While I do not have official confirmation of this connection, I include these names in good faith to assist investigators in identifying potential perpetrators and ensuring accountability.
