

## PRAMS Field Testing Questionnaire

### Screener Questions (English and Spanish):

Mothers are approached at health department clinics or pediatric offices and ask if they would like to participate on a project. If they agree, the recruiter will ask the following questions to determine their eligibility to participate. Mothers are eligible if they answer yes to both questions.

1. Are you 18 years of age or older?
2. Is your infant 12 months old or younger?
