General Comment

Nobody wants our best beef to be exported so the Chinese can eat it. Chinese farm owners do not understand ethical farming either. Harrison (1) reported 60 years ago on conditions in the pig production industry which did not respect the five freedoms established by the Brambell Committee a year later. Today, while in some countries pig welfare has improved, in many others the conditions are worse despite extensive research on the needs and welfare of pigs. Another example of the mismatch between science and what happens in the animal agriculture industry is the misuse of antibiotics in non-therapeutic protocols. Antimicrobial resistance poses a considerable threat to public health, with an estimated 4.95 million human deaths associated with bacterial antimicrobial resistance in 2019 (2, 3). China's high rise pig farms are biological threats.
