The U.S. Department of Agriculture’s Food and Nutrition Service is soliciting comments on a 60-day Federal Register Notice, [91 FR 15591](#), for the reinstatement and revision of the Senior Farmers’ Market Nutrition Program (SFMNP) information collection.
