Sections 202, 205, 223 and 1872 of the Social Security Act, as amended, allow us to collect your information, which we will use to process your request to withdraw your application for benefits. Providing the information is voluntary, but not providing all or part of the information may prevent us from processing your withdrawal request. As law permits, we may use and share the information you submit, including with other Federal agencies, contractors, and others, as outlined in the routine uses within System of Records Notices 60-0089, 60-0090, 60-0320, and 60-0321, available at www.ssa.gov/privacy. The information you submit may also be used in computer matching programs for Federal benefits eligibility or to recoup debts under these programs.
