General Information

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Waiver Information Management System (WIMS) facilitates the request and response process between State agencies and the Food and Nutrition Service (FNS) for all SNAP waiver types and certain other State agency requests. WIMS tracks pending requests, active and expired waivers and non-waivers, and related data reports. The system also allows State agencies and FNS to communicate critical information about requests in a central location.

In the system, cases are separated into "waivers" and "non-waivers". The waivers category includes requests such as administrative waivers and demonstration projects. The non-waivers category covers all other State agency requests that are not technically waivers. This includes major change notifications and certain pilot projects.
