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General Comment

Clinician and administrative engagement in standards development organizations such as the creation of new value sets, reference sets, standards profiles, implementation guides, technical specifications, and ongoing workgroup committee participation, should count as quality improvement activities in Chronic and Post-Acute Care reporting. Clinicians are beneficial for the creation of standards development for existing and new use cases in standards development.
