Monthly Check-in Questions

Federal Project Officers (FPOs) will ask the following questions during monthly calls with Tribal MIECHV grant recipients. Responses will be provided verbally and recorded by the FPO.

- 1. New Households Enrolled**
“During the past month, how many new households enrolled in your Tribal MIECHV program?”
- 2. Households Currently Receiving Services**
“As of the end of the past month, how many households were actively receiving services?”
- 3. Households Who Stopped Services Before Completion**
“During the past month, how many households stopped services before completion?”
- 4. Households Who Completed or Graduated**
“During the past month, how many households completed or graduated from the program?”

PAPERWORK REDUCTION ACT (PRA) OF 1995 (Public Law 104-13) STATEMENT OF PUBLIC BURDEN: The purpose of this information collection is to obtain monthly operational updates from Tribal MIECHV grant recipients to support program monitoring and timely technical assistance.
