Marriage Certificate And Other Proof Of Family Relationship

Aliens electronically filing their I-485 application package, must open the sealed envelope from the Civil Surgeon and upload the completed [Form I-693, Report of Immigration Medical Examination and Vaccination Record](#). USCIS Officers will use the uploaded version of the original Form I-693 from the alien to determine eligibility. Applicants must maintain the original Form I-693 and envelope until a final decision is made on the associated Form I-485. USCIS Officers have the option to review it during the interview or upon request.

Applicants for adjustment of status are generally required to complete an immigration medical examination and submit a properly completed Form I-693 signed by a civil surgeon to show that they are free from health conditions that would render them inadmissible under the health-related grounds.
