We are writing to inform you of the 60-Day Federal Register Notice (FRN) regarding the proposed three-year extension and modifications to the Form GC-859 Nuclear Fuel Data Survey (OMB Control Number 1901-0287). The attached PDFs contain the complete notice as published in the [Federal Register](#) on August 28, 2025, and the proposed form. The current and proposed forms are available at: <https://www.eia.gov/survey/#gc-859>.

Key Proposed Changes include:

- Clarified instructions and definitions based on previous survey feedback.
- Discontinuation of Section B.2 (Reactor License Data) as this information is publicly available.
- Addition of an optional Assembly-Average Initial Enrichment data field in Section C.1.1.
- Reinstatement of Section C.2 (Projected Assembly Discharges) to capture planned changes in reactor operations.

- Reorganization of Non-Fuel Component reporting between sections for simplified tracking.
- Addition of a Damaged Fuel Canister column in Section D.3.3 .
- Updates to appendices for improved clarity.
