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As a future veterinary professional, I believe it is important to continue providing access to animal disease training for individuals who wish to participate. In the event of an animal disease outbreak, more personnel than just veterinarians would be required to limit the spread, so we need to have people trained in disease mitigation and sample collection to prevent the problem from getting worse. Having these measures in place will be critical, particularly if we ever see a sudden increase in disease. These events are unpredictable, so it is best to continue training at a steady pace, so we always have trained teams available. Thus, I support the three year extension for these training activities with the VS.

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
