To be used in connection with the Application for Grazing Permit:

Read entire form—fill out left to right, top to bottom.

TOP:

- 1) On the first blank line, enter the name of corporation, partnership, trust, LLC, or other legal entity as recorded with the state.

BODY OF FORM:

- 2) Fill in the table. Note that the signing authority box (first column) indicated with a red asterisks symbol is to be checked with an "X" to the left of the name of the representative(s) who are authorized by the organization to sign Forest Service grazing applications and permits, AND to send and receive official correspondence.
- 3) Continue entering information in the columns moving left to right. Name, title, mailing address, and share of entity owned OR percentage of entity owned for each.
- 4) In the next blank line below the table, re-enter the name of the corporation, partnership, trust, LLC, or other legal entity as recorded with the state.
- 5) In the third blank line, enter the state in which the corporation, partnership, trust, LLC, or other legal entity is authorized to conduct business in.
- 6) Affix a Seal, if a Corporation.
