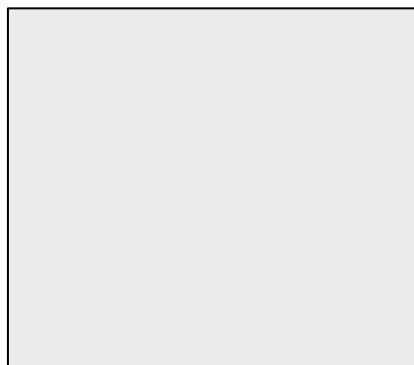


NSF/NCSES AFFIDAVIT OF NONDISCLOSURE

I, _____, do solemnly swear (or affirm) that I have read and understand the contents of the NSF/NCSES LICENSE FOR RESTRICTED-USE DATA are protected under the Confidential Information Protection and Statistical Efficiency Act of 2002 (CIPSEA), 44 U.S.C. 3561- 3568; section 14(i) of the National Science Foundation Act of 1950, as amended, 42 U.S.C. 1873(i); and the Privacy Act of 1974, as amended, 5 U.S.C. 552a, and that when given access to the restricted-use data (hereinafter referred to as the subject file) from the Survey of Doctorate Recipients, the Survey of Earned Doctorates, the National Survey of Recent College Graduates and/or the SESTAT Integrated Database:

If the identity of any individual in the file should be discovered inadvertently, then (a) I will make no use of this knowledge, (b) I will advise the Director, NCSES, of the incident, (c) the information about the individual will be safeguarded, and (d) no one else will be told of the information discovered.
