The Civil Rights Division inside of DOJ will add an additional answer choice to page 4 of the [civilrights.justice.gov form](https://civilrights.justice.gov/form) that will allow users to report about their right to secure, keep and bear arms, as stated in the 2nd, 4th, and 14th Amendments, the Police Pattern or Practice Act, and EO 14206 "Protecting Second Amendment Rights" which secure the natural firearm rights of law-abiding American citizens.

The Civil Rights digital product team will add 'Gun Ownership' as a discrimination type between 'Genetic Information' and 'Immigration' checkboxes (current form screenshot is below).
