AUTHORITIES: The information requested on this form, and the associated evidence, is collected under the Immigration and Nationality Act section 232.

PURPOSE: The primary purpose for requesting the requested information is to determine whether you are eligible to be designated as a USCIS Civil Surgeon. The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (herein “the Department”) will use the information you provide to grant or deny your request. The Department will also use the information to facility a background investigation/check through the U.S. Customs and Border Protection TECS System.

ROUTINE USES: DHS may share the information you provide on this form with other federal, state, local, and foreign government agencies and authorized organizations. The Department follows approved routine uses, as described in the associated published system of records notice [DHS-USCIS-007 Benefits Information System, DHS/USCIS-018 Immigration Biometric and Background Check (IBBC) System of Records, and DHS/CBP-011 U.S. Customs and Border Protection TECS] and the published privacy impact assessments [DHS/USCIS/PIA-067 Civil Surgeon Designation, DHSUSCIS/PIA-064 myUSCIS, and DHS/CBP/PIA-021 TECS System: Platform], which you can find at www.dhs.gov/privacy. DHS may also share the information, as appropriate, for law enforcement purposes or in the interest of national security.

DISCLOSURE: Providing this information is voluntary. However, failure to provide the requested information and any requested evidence, may delay a final decision or result in denial of your request to be designated as a Civil Surgeon.
